ORDINANCE NO. 10

An Ordinance to adopt the provisions of the State Construction Code, to assume responsibility for the administration and enforcement of the Code and to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Township of Rollin.

The Township of Rollin Ordains:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF CODE

Pursuant to Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972 (Compiled Laws of 1948, Sec. 125.1509), the Township of Rollin elects to adopt by reference the State Construction code and to enforce the Code within the boundaries of the Township.

SECTION 2. AGENCY DESIGNATED

The building inspector of the Township of Rollin is designated the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Township under Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, State of Michigan. The Township of Rollin hereby assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout its corporate limits.

SECTION 3. PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE

Publication of this ordinance shall be made by causing a true copy thereof to be inserted once in a newspaper circulating within the Township of Rollin, which insertion shall be made within thirty (30) days after its passage. This ordinance shall not take effect until thirty (30) days after its publication.
