

Ordinance 28. Rollin-Woodstock Sewer Resolution

At a regular meeting of the Township Board of the Township of Rollin, Lenawee County, Michigan, held on the 14th day of October, 1998, at 7 o'clock P.M., Michigan Time.

The following resolution was offered by Ray McGrath and seconded by Elaine Loveland:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROLLIN, as follows:

1. That the Township of Rollin make and cause to be filed a petition in form substantially as follows:

PETITION

TO THE DRAINAGE BOARD FOR THE
HEREINAFTER MENTIONED LENAWEE
COUNTY, MICHIGAN DRAIN PROJECT

The undersigned public corporation hereby petitions for the location, establishment and construction of an intra-county drain project consisting of improvements to the existing treatment plant of the Rollin-Woodstock Sanitary Drain necessary to bring the plant into compliance with new effluent requirements for the NPDES permit, which drain project is necessary for the public health, will be located in the Township of Rollin and will serve property located entirely within the limits of the Village of Addison and the Townships of Rollin and Woodstock. The Rollin-Woodstock Sanitary Drain carries sanitary sewage originating in the County of Lenawee only.

This petition is filed pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 20 of Act No. 40 of the Public Acts of 1956, as amended.

It is understood and agreed that the entire cost of the drain project is to be assessed against public corporations including this petitioner.

A certified copy of the resolution of the governing body of the Township of Rollin authorizing execution of this petition is attached hereto.

2. That the Supervisor and Township Clerk are authorized and directed to execute the petition for and on behalf of the Township of Rollin and to file the same with the Drain Commissioner of the County of Lenawee.

That the Township Board hereby consents to the assessment of part of the cost of the drain project, so located, against the Township of Rollin and hereby agrees that it will pay its share of all costs incurred by the Lenawee County Drain Commissioner or by the Drainage District in the event the drain project, for any reason, is not completed.

4. That all prior resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby rescinded.
