ORDINANCE NO. 9
RECODIFICATION ORDINANCE OF 1986

An Ordinance to repeal and recodify the ordinances of the Township of Rollin, pursuant to the provisions of Act 144 of the Public Acts of 1969. The Township of Rollin Ordains:

SECTION 1. REPEALER

The following ordinances of Rollin Township are repealed:

THE TOWNSHIP OF ROLLIN ORDAINS:
