

ROLLIN TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING
November 10, 2010

Supervisor Jenkins called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Members present were Supervisor Jenkins, Clerk Gust, Treasurer Willett, and Trustees McGrath and Wilson. The veterans present were recognized for their service to the country. Motion by Wilson, support by McGrath to approve the agenda as presented. All aye, motion carried. Motion by Willett, support by McGrath to accept the minutes of the October 13, 2010 meeting as mailed. All aye, motion carried. Motion by McGrath, support by Willett to accept the disbursements as presented. All aye, motion carried. Motion by Willett, support by Wilson to allow the GF to loan the street light fund \$10,000 to be repaid after tax collection. Wilson – yes, McGrath – yes, Willett – yes, Gust – yes, and Jenkins – yes. Motion carried. Motion by Gust, support by McGrath to accept the Treasurer’s report as presented, subject to audit. All aye, motion carried. There were no citizen’s comments.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

There were two appeals: one granted and one denied. Assessor reports December Board of Review will be held December 14, 2010 at 12:00 noon. Building Inspector reports 13 inspections. Electrical Inspector reports 14 inspections. Fire Board reports the siren in Addison is out and will be repaired and paid for by the insurance. Rollin Township is charged with 19 calls for the month of October. Planning Commission recommends approval of a re-zoning request for Christensen on Geneva Hwy. The paperwork will be sent on to Region 2 and Lenawee County. Transfer Station is now on winter hours, and the revenue will be going down. Transfer station will be surveyed by Bartolo surveyors at a cost of \$900.00. Zoning Enforcement reports 4 site reviews, and 2 footer inspections. The county hard labor crews have done some raking and tree trimming at the park. Website reports 8616 hits for October, still increasing in use. Motion by McGrath, support by Wilson to approve the consent agenda. All aye, motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

No action was taken on the bids to set the flagpole at the Cemetery.

NEW BUSINESS

Motion by Gust, support by Willett to approve the Road Commission’s proposal of \$3109.58 to replace two culverts on Mills Road. This will allow the ground to settle before patching and sealcoating work next spring. Wilson – yes, McGrath – yes, Willett – yes, Gust – yes, and Jenkins – yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Gust, support by Willett to allow Jenkins family to use the hall Friday, November 19, 2010 from 3 pm to 10 pm. Four aye, one abstain, motion carried.

Motion by Willett, support by Wilson to allow Skeels family to use the hall Sunday, November 21, 2010 from noon to 5 pm. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by McGrath, support by Gust to allow the McClain family to use the hall Sunday, January 16, 2011 from noon to 6 pm. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Wilson, support by McGrath to allow the Milliman family to use the hall Sunday, February 27, 2011 from 10 am to 4 pm. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by McGrath, support by Gust to allow Russell family to use the park pavilion Saturday, August 6, 2011 all day. All aye, motion carried.

Board comments were heard regarding the culvert on Manitou Road and recommendations for the repair of township roads in 2011. Jenkins will contact the road commission.

Citizen's comments were heard regarding the next step towards civil infractions, and street light outages.
