

ROLLIN TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING**November 14, 2012**

Supervisor Jenkins called the meeting to order with the Pledge at 7:00 pm.

Members present were

Supervisor Jenkins, Clerk Gust, Treasurer Willett, and Trustees McGrath and Wilson. Jenkins recognized the veterans who were present and thanked them for their service. Motion by Wilson, support by McGrath to accept the agenda as presented. Motion by Willett, support by Wilson to accept the minutes of October 10, 2012 as presented. All aye, motion carried. All aye, motion carried. Motion by Willett, support by McGrath to accept the disbursements as presented. Motion by Gust, support by Wilson to accept the Treasurer's report as presented, subject to audit. All aye, motion carried. Correspondence was read from the Planning Commission requesting Ray McGrath be reappointed. Auditor Phil Rubley presented the audit report for Rollin Township. The General Fund is strong and has an adequate fund balance. Street light fund is also adequately funded. Rollin Township received an unqualified opinion. Rubley recommends the township adopt a policy regarding late sewer payments and the charges assessed. Citizen's comments were heard from Jeff Patterson thanking the board for allowing him to care for the township properties.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Appeal board had no meeting. Assessor reports the State Equalized value is up 2.4%. Building Inspector reports 15 inspections. Electrical Inspector reports 8 inspections. Fire Board reports Rollin Township is charged with 11 calls for the month of September. No report for Park. Requests to use the hall were presented: Lamb, June 23, 2013; and Gust June 30, 2013. Zoning reports 7 site reviews. Planning Commission met on November 1st to discuss zoning ordinances. The new zoning ordinance has been submitted for typing and should be back for review by the next planning commission meeting. Transfer station reports average revenue of \$147 for November. Yard waste is still being accepted for composting. Website reports 16778 hits for October. Top visited pages were minutes of the Board,

aquatic weed treatment, and history. Zoning Enforcement reports 7 site reviews. Motion by McGrath, support by Wilson to accept the consent agenda as presented. All aye, motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Jenkins would recommend passing the Dangerous Buildings Ordinance as presented. The County Health Dept has requested the condemnation of a building, and Jenkins would prefer to pass this ordinance prior to condemnation. Motion by Willett, support by Wilson to approve the Noxious Weed Ordinance as presented. Wilson - yes, McGrath- no, Willett - yes, Gust - no, Jenkins - yes, motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business.

Board comments were as follows: Notices normally included in the tax bills will be placed on the table for pick up this year. McGrath thanked the residents for allowing him to serve; Wilson thanked Gust and McGrath for their service. Gust thanked the residents for their support during the poast 18 years. Citizen's comments were heard regarding thanking McGrath and Gust for their service.

Motion by McGrath, support by Gust to adjourn at 8:15 pm. All aye, motion carried.
