

**ROLLIN TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING**  
**April 14, 2010**

Supervisor Jenkins called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Members present were Supervisor Jenkins, Clerk Gust, Treasurer Willett, and Trustees McGrath and Wilson. Agenda amended to include Mike Leonard speaking on the school bond issue. Motion by McGrath, support by Wilson to accept the minutes of the March 10, 2010 meeting as mailed. All aye, motion carried. Motion by Wilson, support by McGrath to accept the minutes of March 25, 2010 Budget Hearing as mailed. Four aye, one abstain, motion carried. Motion by Willett, support by Wilson to accept the disbursements as presented. All aye, motion carried. Motion by Gust, support by McGrath to accept the Treasurer's report as presented, subject to audit. All aye, motion carried. Mr. Mike Leonard was present to discuss the Addison school bond issue to be voted on May 4, 2010. Correspondence was read from MTA, County Road Commission, County Commissioners, Drain Commission, and a letter regarding the clean up of the cemetery. Motion by Wilson, support by Willett to allow signs to be ordered for the Cemetery clean up dates. Wilson – yes, McGrath –yes, Willett – yes, Gust – yes, and Jenkins – yes. Motion carried. Citizen's comments were heard regarding the signs at the cemeteries.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

There was one appeal with two issues, one granted for a deck and the other denied. Assessor reports the roll has been corrected to reflect board of review changes. Building Inspector reports 17 inspections. Electrical Inspector reports 2 inspections. Fire Board reports Rollin Township is charged with 18 calls for the month of February. The fire budget has been reviewed and accepted by the townships. Hospital board reports that the township does not owe anything at this time. Planning Commission is working on the ordinance for outside woodburners and Section 7.2 of the zoning ordinance. The next meeting will be May 13, 2010. Transfer Station revenue is increasing, and summer hours will start May 1, 2010. Summer Hours are 9 AM to 4 PM every Saturday. Zoning Enforcement reports 4 site reviews. Website reports 5648 hits for March, a decrease from February. The Zoning Ordinance is now on the website. Park has ruts in the grass again and needs to be graded and seeded. Motion by McGrath, support by Willett to allow Jerry to contact Grubb to repair the park. Wilson – yes, McGrath – yes, Willett – yes, Gust – yes, and Jenkins - yes. Motion carried. Motion by McGrath, support by Gust to accept the consent agenda. All aye, motion carried.

**OLD BUSINESS**

There was no old business.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Motion by Wilson, support by Willett to allow the fireworks for Posey Lake on July 3, 2010 with a rain date of July 10, 2010. All aye, motion carried.

There was discussion regarding the civil infraction ordinance and recommended changes will be given to the attorney for review.

Motion by McGrath, support by Wilson to sign the contract with Lakeshore Environmental for the treatment of milfoil on Round Lake. Wilson – yes, McGrath – yes, Willett – yes, Gust – yes, and Jenkins – yes. Motion carried.

Motion by McGrath, support by Willett to approve the meeting dates as presented for 2010-2011 fiscal year, with the additional posting of hours for the supervisor. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Wilson, support by Gust to require a denial of a zoning compliance permit and require a new zoning compliance permit fee be paid if the property is not staked when inspected by the zoning officer. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Wilson, support by Willett to allow Callahan family to use the park pavilion June 19 from 2 PM – 7 PM. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Gust, support by Wilson to allow Ehlert family to use the hall May 29 from 5 PM – 8 PM for an anniversary party. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Wilson, support by Willett to allow the Gust family to use the hall June 27 from 9 AM – 7 PM for a graduation party. All aye, motion carried.

Board comments were heard regarding the possibility of a grant to take care of scrap tires, and a question regarding the Manitou Inn cleanup. The insurance adjuster is in the process of addressing this issue. Motion by Wilson, support by McGrath that the insurance company be given notification that they must have a clean up plan to the township within ten days or the township will order the property fenced and cleaned up at owners expense with the cost of clean up added to the tax bill. Four aye, one nay. Motion carried.

Citizens' comments were heard regarding the farmers market and where it is to be held. The township is behind the farmers market but is not a part of the farmers market. The township has offered the park for their use. There were also questions concerning the weevil project on Round Lake, the status of hiring a planning consultant, and a question about Civil Infractions and grandfathering.

Motion by McGrath, support by Wilson to adjourn at 8:50 pm. All aye, motion carried.
