

ROLLIN TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

June 8, 2011

Supervisor Jenkins called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Members present were Supervisor Jenkins, Treasurer Willett, and Trustees Wilson and McGrath. Clerk Gust was absent with notice. Agenda was accepted as presented. Motion by McGrath, support by Wilson to accept the minutes of May 11, 2011 meeting as mailed. All aye, motion carried. Motion by Wilson, support by McGrath to accept the minutes of special meeting on May 19, 2011 as mailed. All aye, motion carried. Motion by Willett, support by McGrath to accept the disbursements as presented. All aye, motion carried. Motion by Wilson, support by McGrath to accept the treasurer's report as presented, subject to audit. All aye, motion carried. Correspondence was read from Lenawee County Road Commission regarding Sandy Beach Rd. Citizen's comments were heard regarding the public accesses and the closing of Sandy Beach Rd.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

There were two appeals, both granted with modifications. Assessor reported that there will be a Board of Review on July 19, 2011. There were 13 building inspections. There were 4 electrical inspections. It was reported that Consumers Energy will trim the trees under the power lines at the cemetery. Motion by Wilson, support by McGrath to have Consumers Energy chip the wood for \$250.00. Roll call vote: Wilson-yes, McGrath-yes, Willett-yes, Jenkins-yes. Motion by Wilson, support by McGrath to deny the request to remove the northwest corner fence of the cemetery at the expense of the township. All aye, motion carried. Fire board reported 69 incidents with 30 in Rollin Township and a new siren has been erected at station one. Planning commission reported that Region 2 Planning Commission completed the review of the zoning ordinances and they will be working on the updates. Transfer station reported that the improvements on the driveway have been completed and the free dump day was received well. Zoning enforcement had 4 site reviews and 3 footer inspections. Website reported that there had been 8247 hits. Park reported that trash had been picked up and a good used basketball hoop is available to be installed. Motion by Wilson, support by McGrath to table the discussion of applying for a grant for park and recreation improvements. All aye, motion carried. Motion by McGrath, support by Wilson to approve the consent agenda. All aye, motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Motion by Jenkins, support by Wilson to table the discussion of Round Lake Estates request for reduction in sewer bill. All aye, motion carried. Motion by McGrath, support by Wilson to have clerk send the access committee members a thank you for serving. All aye, motion carried. Motion by McGrath, support by Wilson to accept the report from the access committee. All aye, motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

A committee will be appointed to look at the Lookout and Grove St public accesses. Motion by Wilson, support by Willett to have the zoning officer to pursue the process to remove the temporary trailer on the Sparrow's property on Skinner Hwy. All aye, motion carried. Motion by Wilson, support by McGrath to allow the McKnight's to use the township hall on July 31, 2011. All aye, motion carried. Motion by Wilson, support by McGrath to allow Colonial Fireworks to have a fireworks display at Posey Lake on July 2, 2011 with a rain date on July 9, 2011. All aye, motion carried. Motion by Willett, support by McGrath to choose Consumers Energy's Option 1 for the replacement of the mercury vapor street lighting when they burn out or fail with the nearest comparable high pressure sodium lighting at no cost. All aye, motion carried.

Board comments were heard that the drain commission is redoing the flood plains mapping.

Citizen's comments were heard about the weevils and Sandy Beach Rd..

Motion by McGrath, support by Wilson to adjourn at 8:30 PM. All aye motion carried.
