

Rollin Township Board Meeting ~ September 26, 2014

-Supervisor Jenkins called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 5:00PM. Members present were Supervisor Jenkins, Treasurer Willett and Trustees Walker and Wilson. Clerk Combs was absent with notice.

-Jenkins stated that the committee had met and performed three interviews. Although they eliminated one candidate, they were deadlocked on the other two. Jenkins thanked Wilson and Walker for their time and effort and asked if they had discussed a salary. Jerry confirmed that Irma had addressed it with each applicant as the board had previously agreed to pay an office assistant \$12 per hour.

-Jenkins agreed that the final two candidates are well qualified. He went on to give details from the interviews he conducted on Thursday. He stated that he felt Kathleen would be the better choice due to her extensive experience with the State of Michigan.

-Walker stated that he felt both candidates brought a lot to the table and would be happy with either one.

-Wilson concurred that both were well qualified and agreed with Walker, either one would be a good choice.

-Willett also agreed that both were certainly qualified but agreed with Jenkins that Kathleen's experience with the State brings certain qualities that would definitely benefit the utilities department as well as all other departments within the Township.

-Discussion ensued regarding working hours and flexibility. Jenkins will be responsible for setting hours.

-Motion by Willett and supported by Walker to offer the position to Kathleen Hacker. Roll Call vote; Wilson – yes, Walker – yes, Willett – yes, Jenkins – yes. All in favor, motion carried.

-No citizen's comments were heard as there were no guests present.

-Motion by Wilson and supported by Willett to adjourn the meeting at 5:36pm. All ayes, motion carried.
